**Topic: Our Amazing World**

### **UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD**

Knowing that people, animals and plants grow and change.

Finding out about different animals and how they are similar or different to each other.

Understanding that as we grow older we change and learn new things.

Finding out about the world around us, and understanding that other people's experiences may be different to our own.

### **COMMUNICATION, LANGUAGE AND LITERACY**

Following instructions and listening to others. Beginning to compose a sentence orally then write it independently by sounding out the words.

Learning to read and write 'tricky' words. Reading whole sentences and short reading books.

Answering questions about characters and events in stories they have heard.

Listening and responding to poems and rhymes.

Letters and Sounds phase 3

### **MATHEMATICS**

Counting on and back from 0-20.

Counting objects with 1:1 correspondence. Recognising, writing and ordering numbers from 1-20.

Beginning to recognise and name 3D shapes and describe some of their properties.

Solving simple number problems.

Adding and subtracting 2 single digit numbers.

Learning about height, weight and capacity.

### **PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT**

Practising handwriting and fine motor skills, especially pencil and scissor control.

Learning to be more independent with dressing for PE and for outdoor play.

Learning about health and wellbeing and how we can keep our bodies healthy.

### **EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN**

Exploring ways to be creative both inside and outside.

Role play linked to our current topics and learning objectives. Music and dance.

Using musical instruments to create different sounds and effects.

Experimenting with different materials.

### **PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT**

Beginning to work more independently and to motivate themselves to complete tasks.

Understanding that people are all different and beginning to take account of other's ideas and opinions.

Making positive behavior choices and sorting out disagreements and disputes independently.

### **RELIGIOUS EDUCATION**

**Easter:** to know the Easter story. To listen to stories about Jesus and understand how we can follow His example.

**Sacraments:** finding out about baptism.

**Pentecost and Mission:** the story of Pentecost. How we can show others Jesus' love.

### **OUT OF HOURS LEARNING EXPERIENCES**

Practice reading and writing at home. Continue to work in Phonics books.
