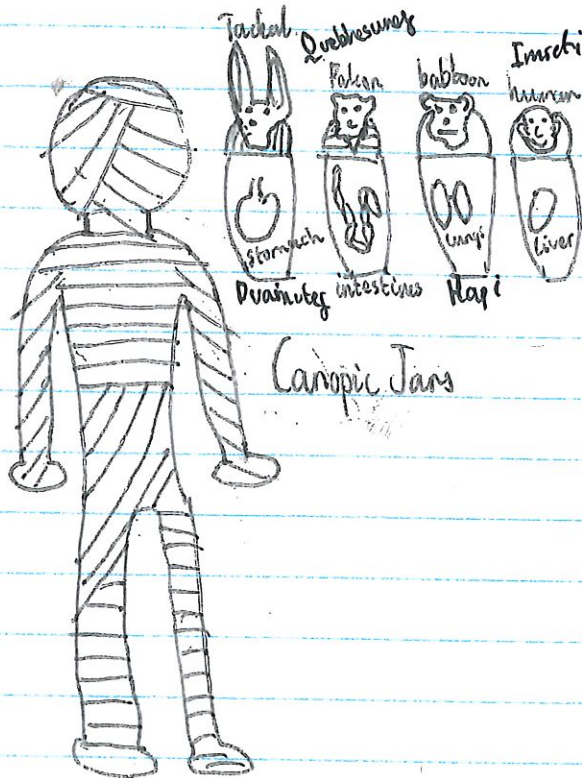
Farmers mummification

Many Egyptian pharaohs were put inside coffins and tombs but where did the farmers go and get mummified. Farmers usually were just buried underground by family or friends. Farmers didn't get mummified because to get mummified

was very expensive and farmers didn't have much clothes or gold, so their life depended on money.

Coffins and tombs

Coffins were usually made out of pure, solid gold and had patterns on for decoration, the decoration was wings which meant that it would protect the body from intruders. Tombs were painted with different colours and pictures of Egyptian myths and stories. Slaves brought in food into the tombs for the afterlife.
