PE

Maths

Don't forget to go on my maths for this week's homework And to check on purple mash as well for some maths 'to dos'	
Monday	<p><u>One more and one less</u></p> <p>Get some raisins, grapes, cereal pieces. Place some on a plate. If the grown up with you says 'one more', add one more and say what number you have now. If they say 'one less', eat one and count how many you have left.</p> <p>Build a tower with bricks. Can you build another tower with 10 more bricks? Can you build another with 10 less bricks?</p>
Tuesday	<p>Make a poster to show number bonds to 10 eg draw a group of 4 cats, then a group of 6 cats. Do a picture for each number bond- $9+1$, $8+2$, $7+3$, $6+4$, $5+5$. Write the number bonds underneath.</p>
Wednesday	<p>Make towers of bricks to show the number bonds to 20- a pair of towers with 19 and 1, 18 and 2, 17 and 3, 16 and 4, 15 and 5, 14 and 6, 13 and 7, 12 and 8, 11 and 9, 10 and 10. Write the number bonds in your red book.</p>
Thursday	<p>Write subtraction number sentences for the number bonds to 20 eg $20-1=19$, $20-2=18$..... And so on.</p>
Friday	<p><u>Maths Games</u></p> <p>Have a go at inventing your own maths game. Link to a blog on maths games: https://matr.org/blog/fun-maths-games-activities-for-kids/</p>

You can either make a mini book about the events of Holy week, leading up to Easter Sunday or write in your red book. Start each day with a new heading and write about the things that happened on that day.




