Look through the **Air Resistance and Parachute Experiment PowerPoint**. Create your own experiment exploring air resistance by making a parachute. You can make it out of a plastic bag, string and a weight (a toy or even some blutack) There are more ideas in the PowerPoint. You could drop your parachute from different heights and see how long they take to fall. Or you could change the size of your parachute and compare the speed it takes to fall. Don't forget to change only 1 variable (e.g. height OR size) and record your results. What did you learn? Tell us about it on the blog!
