Tuesday	SPAG Warm up: Complete the activity on Main & Subordinate clauses.	We live in a <i>democracy</i> which comes from the Ancient Greek system. Read What is Democracy? Look at the Glossary on the final page and write a definition for each word. Use a dictionary and the PowerPoint to help you. Can you talk to an adult in your family about what democracy means?
Wednesday	SPAG Warm up: Purple Mash Box the Word.	Read through the Lesson Ancient Greek Democracy and learn about how democracy began. Complete the Comparing Democracy activity. (Bronze – 1 star, Silver – 2 stars, Gold – 3 stars)
Thursday	One of the issues that the government are discussing at the moment is when to reopen schools. Should school reopen? Read about what the government are saying on Newsround: https://www.bbc.co.uk/newsround/52393241 What do you think? Would you say yes or no? Can you think of reasons for and against? On Purple Mash write down both sides of the debate. You will find a template in your To Do list.

Write a letter to Layla Moran telling her how you feel about schools being reopened. (If there is another issue you feel more strongly about then feel free to write about that!) Experiment 1: Buoyancy Try making 2 different shaped boats out of tin foil and then add weights to them (e.g. marbles, coins or lego bricks) Which boat will hold the most weight before it sinks? Can you design another boat that will hold even more?



Read the PowerPoint in your pack about water resistance and carry out **Experiment 2: Boat Race!** Make 3 different shaped boats and see how fast they travel across some water. You could do this in a bath/paddling pool/local stream but try and make it as fair as possible! Which boat travels the fastest through the water and can you explain why?
