

SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNOLOGICAL UNDERSTANDING:

Science:

Animals, including Humans:

Pupils will learn how animals have offspring and grow into adults, look at life cycles and find out what animals need to survive, study how balanced diets and exercise help humans to keep fit and healthy.

UNDERSTANDING ENGLISH, COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE:

English:

Focusing on punctuation, extending sentences, adding description, and practicing handwriting through our topic. We will be producing many different text types including, story writing, poetry, non-fiction texts, books, travel brochures, fact files, character descriptions etc.

Phonics:

Recapping on all previously learnt phonics and learning phase 5 phonics ready for the phonics screening in October. Focus in first half term: understanding different ways to read and write the same sounds. Focus in second half term: high frequency words reading and writing.

MATHEMATICAL UNDERSTANDING:

Number:

counting in 2, 3, 5 and 10's, place value of 2-digit numbers, comparing numbers, solving number problems, addition and subtraction methods and problem solving, recalling numbers facts, multiplication (2/ 5 and 10 x tables) and division problems, fractions (read, write and recognise)

Measurement:

Standard units for weight, length, temperature and capacity, time and money problems, writing the time to five-minute intervals.

Geometry:

Identify and describe 2D and 3D shapes, comparing their properties, position including clockwise and anticlockwise and turns.

Statistics:

Interpret and construct pictograms, tally charts, block diagram and tables. Answer questions about the data and what it represents.
