Unit: Revelation

L.O. To understand the story of the Transfiguration

Today, I would like to share with you another story in which Jesus is being revealed as the son of God. It was about a week after Jesus told His disciples that He would suffer, be killed, and be raised to life. He took Peter, James, and John up a mountain to pray. While praying, His appearance was changed into a glorified form, and His clothing became dazzling white. Then Moses and Elijah appeared and talked with Jesus about His death that would soon take place. After that, a cloud appeared and a voice said, "This is My Son, whom I have chosen, whom I love; listen to Him!" The cloud lifted, Moses and Elijah had disappeared, and Jesus was alone with His disciples who were still very much afraid. Jesus warned them not to tell anyone what they had seen until after His resurrection.

The purpose of the transfiguration of Jesus into His heavenly glory was to give His disciples a better understanding of who Jesus was. The disciples, who had only known Him in His human body, now had understood that Jesus was the son Of God, though they could not fully comprehend it yet. Still, that gave them the reassurance they needed after hearing the shocking news of His coming death.

Think about these questions:

- What happened at the Transfiguration?
- What does 'transfigured' mean?
- What does God say about His Son at the Transfiguration?
- Why is light an important symbol to reveal God's Son?
- What are the similarities between the Presentation in the temple and the Transfiguration?
- What do the Transfiguration and Presentation in the temple tell us about Jesus?

Writing activity

- **Bronze** – Retell the story in detail
- **Silver** - Write 6 questions you would like to ask Peter, James and John about what happened during the Transfiguration and then write the answers to your questions.
- **Gold** – Write a conversation between Peter, James and John on the way down – how would they be feeling, what questions would they have for each other, what had the voice of God told them to do, what will they do next?
